

## Learning support for Mathematics courses

- **Instructor and/or TA office hours** – the instructor and TA (where applicable) are there for the students. They want to help you succeed. Their office hours are commonly underutilized. Go there!
- **Mathematics Consulting Center (MCC)** – free tutoring run by the Mathematics Department. Tutoring is done by undergraduates who have been successful in their mathematics courses and by mathematics graduate students. They are open every day, including weekends. - **Study Halls** – extra help sessions for Math 1022 and Math 1041. The sessions are in the evening and are run by mathematics graduate students. No appointment is necessary. Course instructors have information.
- **PASS Sessions** -- Peer Assisted Study Sessions for Math 1021 and Math 1022. There are organized by the Student Success Center (<https://studentsuccess.temple.edu/programs/pass/index.html>) and run by undergraduate students who have been successful in the course and who also attend the class. Course instructors have details.
- **Student Success Center (SSC)** – they offer a variety of STEM tutoring, including for mathematics, by successful undergraduates. Appointments are made through their website. (<https://studentsuccess.temple.edu/programs/stem/tutoring.html>)
